We also are preparing for a two week tour in October with a church from Sydney. The initial preparations appear to be coming along nicely.

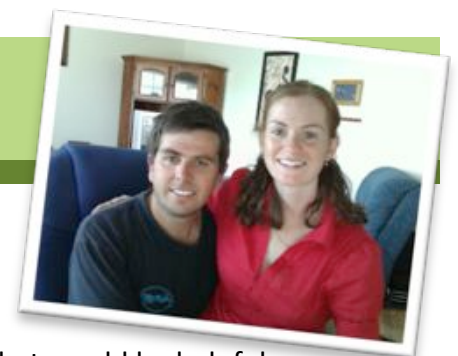
At the end of the month, we plan to attend a training course put on by Missions Interlink called MIST (Missions Interlink Short Term
