Growth Groups are weekly small groups where people dig into the Bible, pray and care for each other under the leadership of mature Christians.

They are primarily for Christian maturity but will also be places where people magnify God, grow in concern for mission, express membership, and serve in ministry. Groups run for one year at a time.

Our hope is that every Christian who is part of HBC would commit to a Growth Group.

The goals for Growth Groups:

The goal of every Growth Group should be that everyone grows together to become more like Christ.

The expectations for Growth Groups:

People in Growth Groups should:

- be committed to church and coming regularly
- be committed to the group and coming regularly
- respect their Growth Group leaders

Groups can also expect to:

- Serve together as needed on church rosters or providing supper for NextStep
- Adopt and support a missionary for the group.

The expectations for Growth Group Leaders:

Leaders should expect to:

- Prepare the study each week
- Help the group love and care for each other
- Be aware of how group members are growing in maturity
- Train others in reading, understanding and teaching the Bible.
